INTERACTIVE SESSION ON COURSE OUTCOMES AND LEARNING OBJECTIVES

An Interactive Session was conducted on “Course Outcomes and Learning Objectives” on 18th November 2019 at Amphitheatre 223, St. Xavier's University Kolkata for all the faculty members of the University. It was a two-hour session from 1:30 P.M to 3:30 P M, conducted by Dr. Kanika Chatterjee, Prof. Dept. of Commerce, Former Director of IQAC, Former Nodal officer of AISHE, University of Calcutta.

She started off with a power point presentation and introduced the relevance of Course Outcomes and Learning objectives in the present syllabus. She further discussed about the basic concepts and importance of learning outcomes. Thereafter she moved on with a detailed discussion about the preparation of Learning outcomes of programme. She stated that modern education needs to be changed from syllabus oriented to outcome-based education where we can measure the development of the student. She discussed the applicability of Bloom's taxonomy in present syllabus and suggested that the learning outcomes should be brief and aligned with departmental Vision and Mission. Further, she emphasized on the fact that each department should keep all the records of each departmental events.
