Internal Quality Assurance Cell Organises Training on ISO 9001:2015

A three-day training programme on **Awareness and Internal Quality Audit of QMS based on ISO 9001:2015** was organised by St. Xavier's University, Kolkata, from 28.10.2025 to 30.10.2025. The training aimed to enhance participants' understanding of the principles, requirements, and implementation strategies of ISO 9001:2015 standards to promote a culture of quality, continuous improvement, and customer satisfaction within academic and administrative processes.

Objectives of the Training

The key objectives of the programme were:

- To familiarise participants with the fundamentals and structure of ISO 9001:2015.
- To understand the various quality management principles and their application in higher education.
- To build competence in documenting, implementing, and auditing QMS processes.
