

EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

The Induction Ceremony and Orientation Programme for B.Com. (Hons.), B.M.S. and M.Com. first year students for the academic year 2023-24 was organized to welcome and acclimatize the students to the environment of the university. 
